Methods of Payment

1. Termly – Fees must be paid by the first day of term or a late payment charge of £25.00 will apply. Fees may be paid by debit card, by cheque or by bank transfer at no extra charge; credit card payments incur a 2.5% surcharge.
2. Annually in advance – There is a 2% discount for annual fees received by **Friday 20th August 2016**.
3. Monthly – Parents have the option to spread the costs of fees by monthly payments with our approved provider. Please contact the Finance Office for more information. The school does not accept any direct monthly payments.

Notes on the Fees:

Nursery Rates

*Our daily rates in nursery are based on a minimum three days attendance to qualify for these rates, other sessional rates are available when booking in advance for the term. Nursery – Pre Reception ad-hoc hours are charged at £6.70 per hour. Baby rooms ad-hoc hours are charged at £7.85 per hour and include nappies and wipes

School Hours

Early Years (Baby, Nursery and Pre-Reception) are open 7.30am – 6.00pm. We close for Bank Holidays, staff inset days, one week at Christmas, one week at Easter and two weeks prior to the start of the autumn term.

Reception – Year 2 – Core hours 8.30am -3.30pm. Breakfast can be booked from 7.30am and after school club runs from 3.30pm – 6.00pm. There is also a range of after school activities between 3.30pm – 4.30pm for which there is a charge if run by an external coach. Children with older sibling's finishing school at 4.30pm may stay in after school club up to this time free of charge (unless they are attending a paid activity).

Year 3 –Year 13 – Core term time hours are 8.30am-4.30pm. Breakfast can be booked from 7.30am and after school club runs from 4.45pm -5.45pm.

Additional Funding

Early Years Funding: The school continues to be part of the LEA Early Years funding scheme until 31 August 2017. From the 1st September this will no longer apply. The school administers this funding over 5 days, 3 hours per day. Parents who enroll into Reception having spent a year or more already in our EYFS will benefit from a reduced fee rate of £2,500 per term, for the Reception year.

Childcare Vouchers: The school is set up to take childcare vouchers (CCV); please make arrangements with the finance department if you would like to use this payment method. CCV can only be used for fees for the early year's children but can be used for before and after school care, trips and flexi boarding up until the age of 16.

Dining

Breakfast Club is open from 7.30am - 8.30am and must be booked in advance. Please note breakfast is served until 8.00am with the remainder of the period made up of the care element.

Lunch and snacks (Reception to Year 13) are included in the fees. Pupils are required to eat the meals and snacks at school which are prepared and cooked daily on site. Special diets can be catered for. Snacks include a drink and piece of fruit at break time and drink and biscuit at 4.30pm.

Tea: A more substantial tea is served at 4.30pm, prior to the after school clubs, which should be ordered in advance (see charges schedule).

After School Clubs and Activities

After School Club (Year Reception – Year 2) is available from 3.30pm-6.00pm and must be booked termly in advance (see charges schedule). A range of after school clubs are run between 3.30pm - 4.30pm as well as a light tea served after 4.30pm (see charges schedule). Pupils can also choose from activities such as tennis, ballet, judo which are run by outside staff and are charged for separately. All chargeable clubs must be paid for at the time of booking.

After School Clubs (Year 3 – Year 13) are available from 4.45pm-5.45pm each day. Pupils can choose from a wide range of activities and there is no additional charge for clubs run by school staff. Clubs run by outside staff are charged and must be paid for at the time of booking.

Full and Flexi Boarding

International students requiring a visa are required to pay fees upfront as part of their visa application. International Boarding fees include all meals and the initial airport transfers. There are additional charges for dry cleaning, trips, music tuition, exam costs, transport and EAL lessons. Pupils aged 9 and over may be full or flexi boarders. Flexi boarding is available 7 nights a week and includes an evening meal and breakfast.

Exam Fees and Work Experience

Exam entry fees and work experience costs are charged.

School Transport

We operate several bus routes (subject to numbers) to and from Sherfield each day, coming in from areas such as Fleet, Mortimer, Woolhampton, Blackwater, Reading and Basingstoke. Please note that the cost of transport is spread

throughout the academic year so no refunds can be made for any journeys not taken. For further information or if interested in using the bus service please contact the operations manager.
